

Code of Conduct

The MCA is a community dedicated to supporting every visitor to experience a beautiful path of peace and excellence. We expect persons using the MCA to act maturely, to behave responsibly, and to respect the rights and dignity of others. ALL visitors to the MCA are required to conduct themselves with these **CORE VALUES**:

Spread Peace

Treat everyone you meet with compassion (Qur'an 10:10)

- 1. NO ENGAGING IN ACTIVITY THAT HINDERS the flow of attendees, obstructs entryways/walkways, or creates a safety hazard.
- 2. NO OFFENSIVE OR DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOR likely to provoke a disturbance or infringe on the rights or peace of other patrons in the MCA, including: gestures; obscenities; slurs based on race, gender, or ethnicity; sexually explicit language/conduct; excessive noise or music.
- 3. MUST BE FULLY CLOTHED or wearing apparel that obscures, disguises, or conceals the face, unless for medical or religious
- 4. NO APPAREL THAT MAY PROVOKE OR INCITE VIOLENCE or create a disturbance.

Care for All Ages & Abilities

Rush to be kind and merciful. (Qur'an 17:24)

- 5. MINORS MUST BE SUPERVISED AT ALL TIMES. Supervising adults are responsible for the actions of the youth they accompany. Visitors 17 years of age and younger are required to be accompanied at all times by a parent or supervising adult age 21 or older. Proof of age via proper identification may be required for the youth or supervising adult.
- 6. SUPPORT OUR ELDERS. ACCOMMODATE SPECIAL NEEDS with kindness and patience.

Be Respectful.

Love for others what you love for yourself. (Qur'an 4:135)

- 7. PARK LEGAGALY. Unauthorized parking will be towed at owner's expense.
- 8. NO PHOTOGRAPHING OR VIDEOTAPING on MCA property in an intimidating or threatening manner, or in a manner that compromises the safety or security of any individual or entity at the MCA. No photography or video recording is allowed without permission by the MCA management.
- 9. NO UNAUTHORIZED COMMERCIAL ACTIVITY or solicitation. Solicitation requires written approval from a current MCA official.
- 10. NO EVENT ACTIVITY NOT AUTHORIZED IN ADVANCE by MCA Management.

Keep Clean & Green.

Don't be excessive. Be mindful.(Qur'an 6:141)

- 11. NO FOOD OR OPEN BEVERAGES in the prayer halls (i.e. drink bottles must be closed) or on the turfs.
- 12. NO ANIMALS unless necessary for special needs.
- 13. NO LITTERING.

Keep Safe.

Harm no one.(Qur'an 33:58)

- 14. NO UNSAFE ACTIVITIES such as horseplay, use of physical force, fighting, running, skateboarding, skating, or riding cycles, scooters or Segways in the hallways or pedestrian areas.
- 15. NO FIREARMS (including replicas) or any object that can be used or mistaken as a weapon.
- 16. NO SMOKING OR VAPING.
- 17. NO VIOLATING ANY FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL LAW OR ORDINANCE.
